**DECLARATION** 

ON THE ISSUE OF MEASURES TAKEN AGAINST ICC OFFICIALS

BY THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

The International Association of Judges (IAI) expresses grave concern about the coercive

measures reportedly taken against ICC officials by the Investigative Committee of the Russian

Federation.

The aforesaid measures appear to be related to the exercise of the ICC's legitimate mandate,

notably the prosecution of the gravest international crimes, and might result in a serious interference to

the exercise of that mandate.

The prosecution of judges and prosecutors who legitimately perform their duty raises utmost

apprehension as it jeopardizes the liberty of the persons concerned and strikes against the core

constitutional principle of an independent judiciary.

The unjustified discredit cast over the ICC might contribute to the impunity of those who

allegedly might be found to have committed war-crimes, although we are confident that the ICC staff

and officials will continue to exercise their duty with professionalism and impartiality.

The IAI therefore states its opposition to the initiative of the Russian Investigative Committee,

and does so to safeguard the common values shared by the international community and in order that

accountability for international crimes be ensured.

Finally, the IAJ expresses its solidarity with the judges and prosecutors involved, and with the

ICC as a whole.
